Celebrity Mercury (2/26-3/8). 182 sickened. Cause: Norovirus

Celebrity Mercury (3/8-3/19). 406 sickened. Cause: Norovirus

Crystal Symphony (11/2-11/21). 37 sickened. Cause: Unknown

Queen Victoria (1/4-1/12). 179 sickened. Cause: Norovirus

Queen Victoria (1/12-27). 168 sickened. Cause: Unknown
